Southern California Hot Rodders Get Special Invitation To MOPAR TWIN 25's AT IRWINDALE SPEEDWAY

Each Hot Rod is a "Special Pass" For Preferred Parking

LAGUNA BEACH, CA — A great tradition is renewed this April when Southern California hot rodders and exciting Midget racing action are reunited again at the MOPAR TWIN 25's AT IRWINDALE! Recalling the glory days of Los Angeles' Gilmore Stadium decades ago, special invitations are being mailed to the region's hot rod enthusiasts to drive their favorite classic car to the MOPAR TWIN 25's AT IRWINDALE, where every hot rod is a 'special pass' for preferred parking for only \$3.

More than an auto race, the MOPAR TWIN 25's AT IRWINDALE is becoming an exciting, new, multi-faceted event for Southern California car culture. "In fact, we'll have the famous #27 Edelbrock V8-60 'Offy Killer' midget on display in the midway of the MOPAR TWIN 25's AT IRWINDALE. This is the midget with a V8-60 Ford Flathead engine built by Vic Edelbrock Sr.—one of the founding fathers of hot rodding—that beat the midgets powered by Offenhauser engines. Edelbrock's hot rodded production engine had more horsepower than purpose-built race engines!"

Over 30 hot rod businesses in Southern California received packages of race promotional flyers to distribute to customers, plus hot rod organizations such as L.A. Roadsters, Over The Hill Gang, Hot Rods

Unlimited, Inland Roadsters, Sultans of Long Beach and Bay City Roadsters are distributing flyers to their membership.

Presented by Mission Foods, the MOPAR TWIN 25's is a USAC Midget race offering a spectacular \$50,000 bonus prize to a driver who wins both of the night's 25-lap feature races. The exciting challenge of the Twin 25's format comes from the fact that the winner of the first 25-lap feature race must start dead last in the second 25-lap feature race.
